



Golf Club Dress Code Policy

As a private members' golf club, we uphold a standard of dress that reflects both the tradition and spirit of the game and of our Club. Members and guests are kindly asked to adhere to the following dress code on the course and in the clubhouse.

On the Golf Course

We want everyone to feel comfortable whilst playing, all we ask is that all golfers wear appropriate golf attire.

- Smart knee length shorts are permitted.
- Golf shoes with soft spikes or spikeless soles only. **NO METAL SPIKES.**

Items Not Permitted on the Course or Practice Facilities:

- Denim, jeans, tracksuits, or gym wear.
 - T-shirts, football shirts, or tops with large logos or slogans.
 - Cargo shorts, excessively short shorts, or multi-pocketed trousers.
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In the Clubhouse

The clubhouse maintains a smart casual dress code and provides further flexibility for using the facility whilst not golfing.

Acceptable Attire:

- Appropriate golf attire.
- Clean, dry footwear (no golf shoes in the dining room).
- Jeans are permitted whilst using the Clubhouse.

Not Permitted whilst using lounge bar and dining room areas:

- Waterproofs, hats or visors.
 - Sportswear, tracksuits, ripped jeans, or overly casual attire.
 - Wet or muddy clothing of any kind.
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NB. Juniors 12 and under should dress for comfort and with appropriate footwear (trainers are allowed)
